


Program Updates

What You Should Already Be Doing

- 2. Connect with your AiA Teammate

1. Scheduling Appointments

- Refer to the scheduler list for contact information
- You should have received an email from Teagan O'Bar inviting you to a sharepoint folder that contains the scheduler contact information

2. Connect with your AiA Teammate

- The sharepoint folder from Teagan O'Bar also contains a list of AiA teams with contact information
- Every C&C Leader will have someone partnered with them (MOAA Staff, MOAA Board of Directors, Advisory Council, or Virtual Chapter)
- Connect with them if you have not already!



3. Review the Materials

- Start studying the issue papers for the three topics
- Review the Team Packet, Member of Congress list, and State Demographics page for more information
- Does the Member of Congress already support these issues? Do your research!



4. Log Your Meetings

- Have a meeting scheduled? Let us know.

- It is most important to document your appointments AFTER your meetings!
- There will be a 'Document Your Appointment' Station at the lunch venue.



5. Council Participation

- Encourage your Council to participate from home.
- Have a few meetings you won't be able to get to while you are in DC? Do them virtually before or after the campaign and invite another person from your Council to join!
- Send out the 'Call to Action' campaigns and ask your Council to participate!

- We need data! Knowing how your meetings went informs our next steps:
 - Following up with offices
 - Making contact with all 435 voting offices on the Hill
 - Informs any meetings we will have with the office in the future!



Total Number of Congressional Offices Contacted




Total number of congressional offices contacted for Advocacy in Action through the Legislative Action Center, through a meeting, and/or visiting the legislator's office.



Total number of AiA calls-to-action sent through the Legislative Action Center, broken down by state.








Heat Map - Congressional Offices Contacted

Total number of congressional offices contacted for Advocacy in Action (meetings scheduled, meetings conducted, offices contacted but no meeting) that were reported to MOAA National.


