



Application and Guidelines

- Nomination requirements are based on accomplished duties or completed tasks above and beyond the recipient's normal responsibilities.
- Provide 3-5 bullet points of notable accomplishments per nomination.
- Nomination must be submitted at least 45 days before the presentation date. The award certificate will be accompanied by a signed card from the President and a challenge coin.
- If the award recipient has previously received an award, the next eligible award will be considered.
