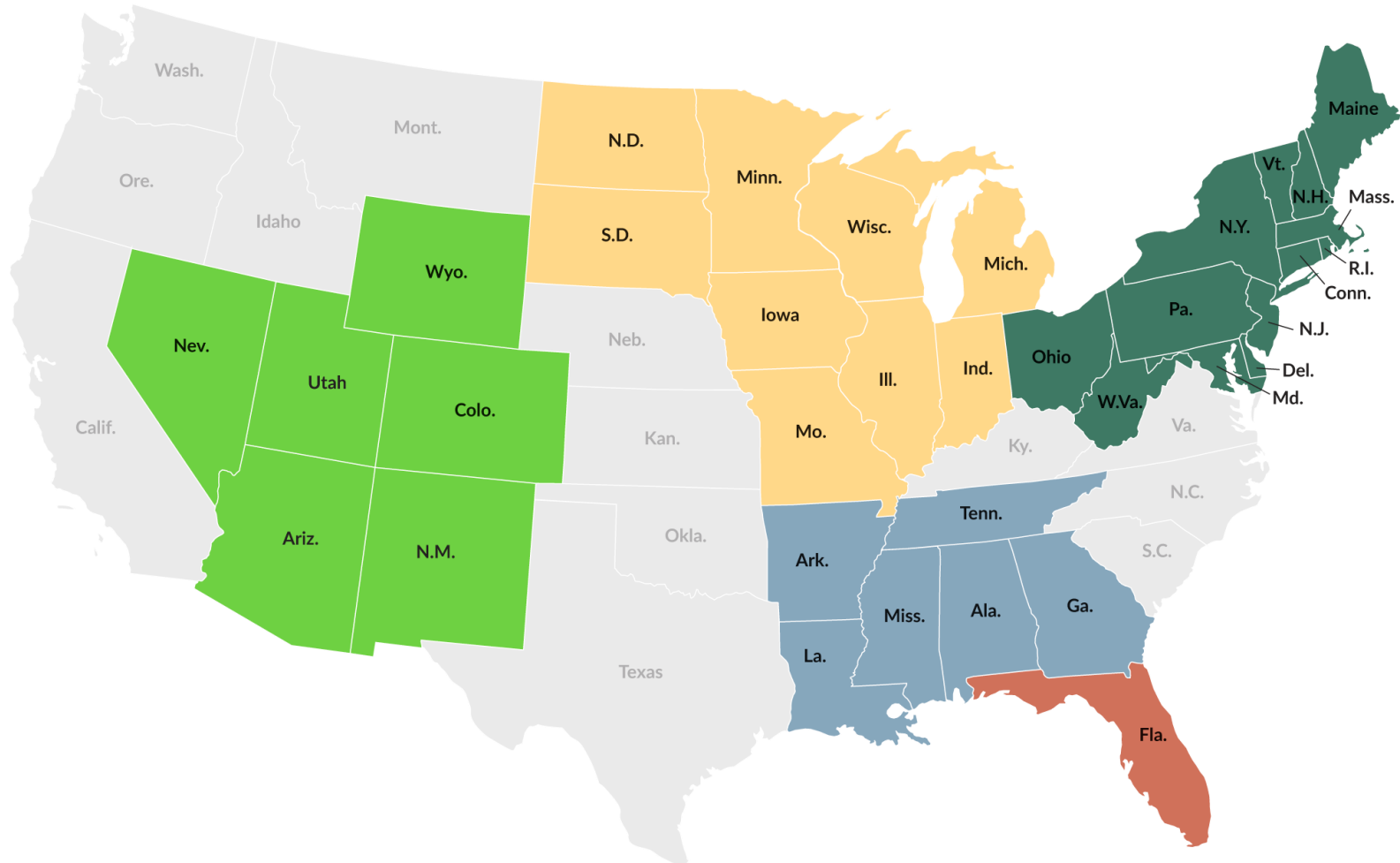

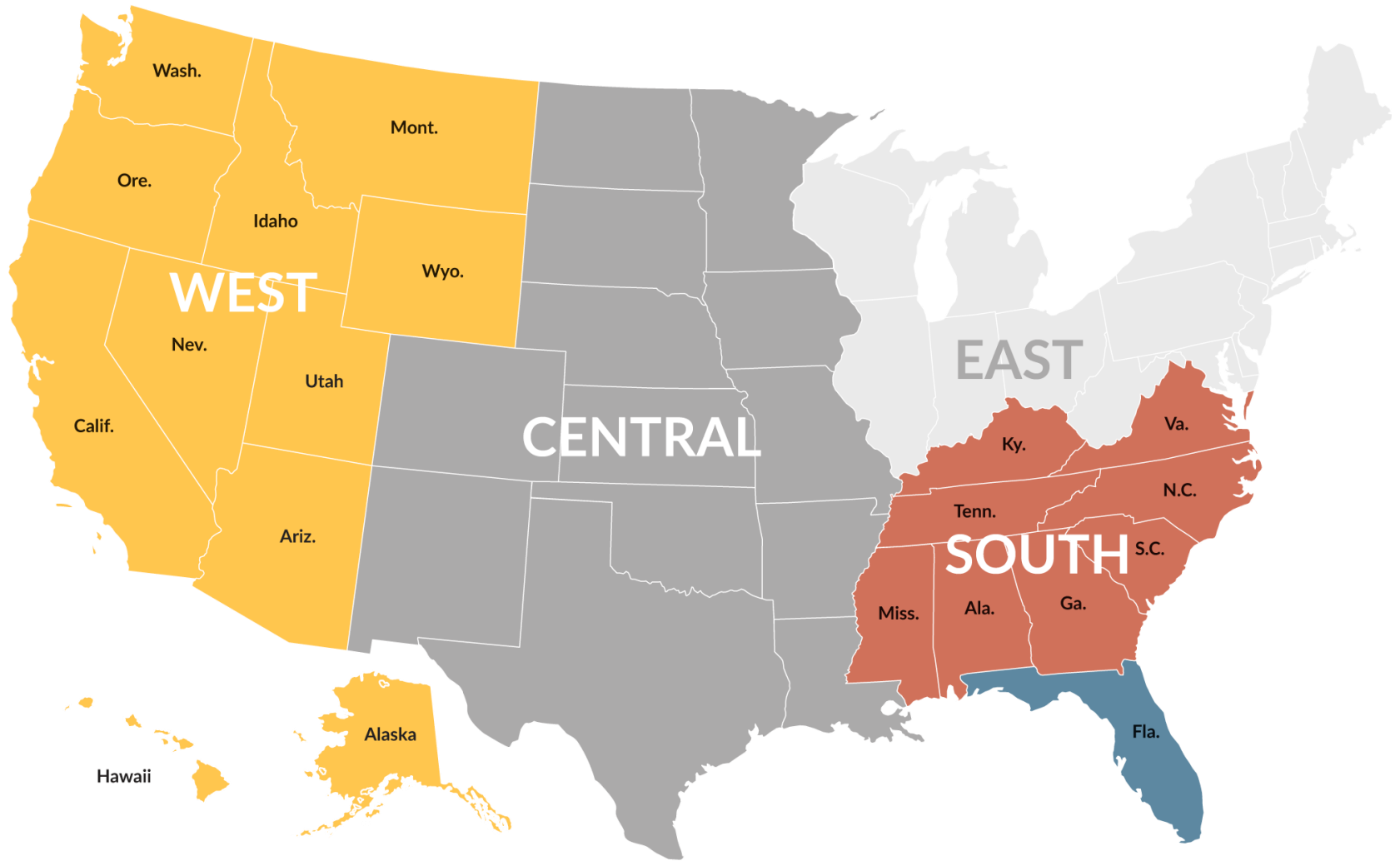

- **Leadership Award (w/lapel pin)**
  - First level award to council/chapter leader
- **President's Award**
  - Second level award to council/chapter leader
- **Chairman's Award**
  - Contact Council and Chapter Affairs for guidance

# Individual Annual Awards

- **Surviving Spouse Liaison Excellence Award**
  - Recognizes a Surviving Spouse Liaison who has demonstrated excellence in ensuring fellow survivors remain connected to the military family and participate in local and national programs and advocacy efforts. (Portal: Mar/April – 1 Jun)
- **Col Steve Strobridge Legislative Chair Award**
  - Recognizes an affiliate Legislative Chair or Liaison who has demonstrated superior service to their council/chapter and national MOAA in support of national and/or state legislation which affects servicemembers, veterans, retirees, and their families. (Portal: Mar/Apr – 1 Jun)

# Organizational Annual Awards

- **Col. Marvin J. Harris Communications Award**
  - Recognizes annually those councils and chapters that do an outstanding job communicating with their members in both Print/E-Newsletter and Website categories. (Portal: Nov – Feb 1)
- **Levels of Excellence Award**
  - Recognizes annually, at three levels, those councils and chapters demonstrating excellence in supporting the MOAA mission through grassroots advocacy, community engagement and growing membership. (Portal: Feb/Mar – May 1)

# Application and Guidelines

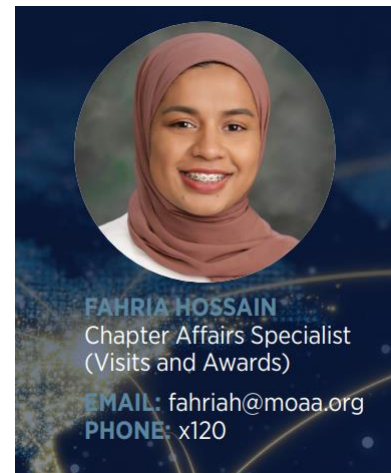
- Nomination requirements are based on accomplished duties or completed tasks above and beyond the recipient's normal responsibilities.
- Provide 3-5 bullet points of notable accomplishments per nomination.
- Nomination must be submitted at least **45** days before the presentation date. The award certificate will be accompanied by a signed card from the President and a challenge coin.
- If the award recipient has previously received an award, the next eligible award will be considered.
